COURSE # WL1 & WL2: PAINTING WITH OILS & ACRYLICS

Please bring the following to the first class:

1. Acrylic or oil paints (Recommended brands are Grumbracher and Windsor Newton)

Colors: Titanium white (large tube)	Ultramarine Blue	Raw Umber
Cadmium yellow medium,	Viridian Green	Yellow Ochre
Cadmium Orange	Permanent Green	Burnt Sienna
Alizarin or Quinacridone Crimson	Cadmium Red	Burnt Umber

Optional Colors:

Lemon Yellow	Manganese Blue
Cobalt Violet	Cobalt Blue
Naples Yellow	

2. If you are using oils, please get a half-gallon container of turpenoid.
It is expensive but you will be reusing it. If you are using acrylics, water is satisfactory.
3. Two cans (coffee can size) or two wide-mouth jars. An additional jar with a tight fitting lid is also needed.
4. Soft, cotton rags (No paper towels please)
5. Palette. A paper palette is the most convenient for use in class but a larger size palette is preferable.
6. Pre-stretched canvases (Bring at least one 20" x 24" to the first class. Do not use canvas board)
7. At least three brushes of various sizes, rounds and or flats are okay, white bristle is suitable for oils and acrylics.
8. A smock or an old shirt
