## **Fear-Free Beginner Drawing Materials List**

- 1. Newsprint drawing pad 14" x 17" (top bound not side bound)
- 2. Regular drawing paper pad approximately 11"x14" (best if spiral bound at top of pad)
- 3. Drawing pencils # b, 2b, 4b one of each, General Pencil Co's "Kimberly" line if very good and inexpensive, others that are good are Faber-Castell, Staedtler, Caran d' Ache
- 4. Vine Charcoal (medium or soft)
- 5. Compressed charcoal pencil, one medium and one soft (I recommend General Pencil Co.)
- 6. Kneaded Eraser (probably need several, they are inexpensive- I recommend Prismacolor kneaded erasers, avoid store brands)
- 7. Plastic, white eraser you only need one
- 8. Matte spray fixative -one can is fine
