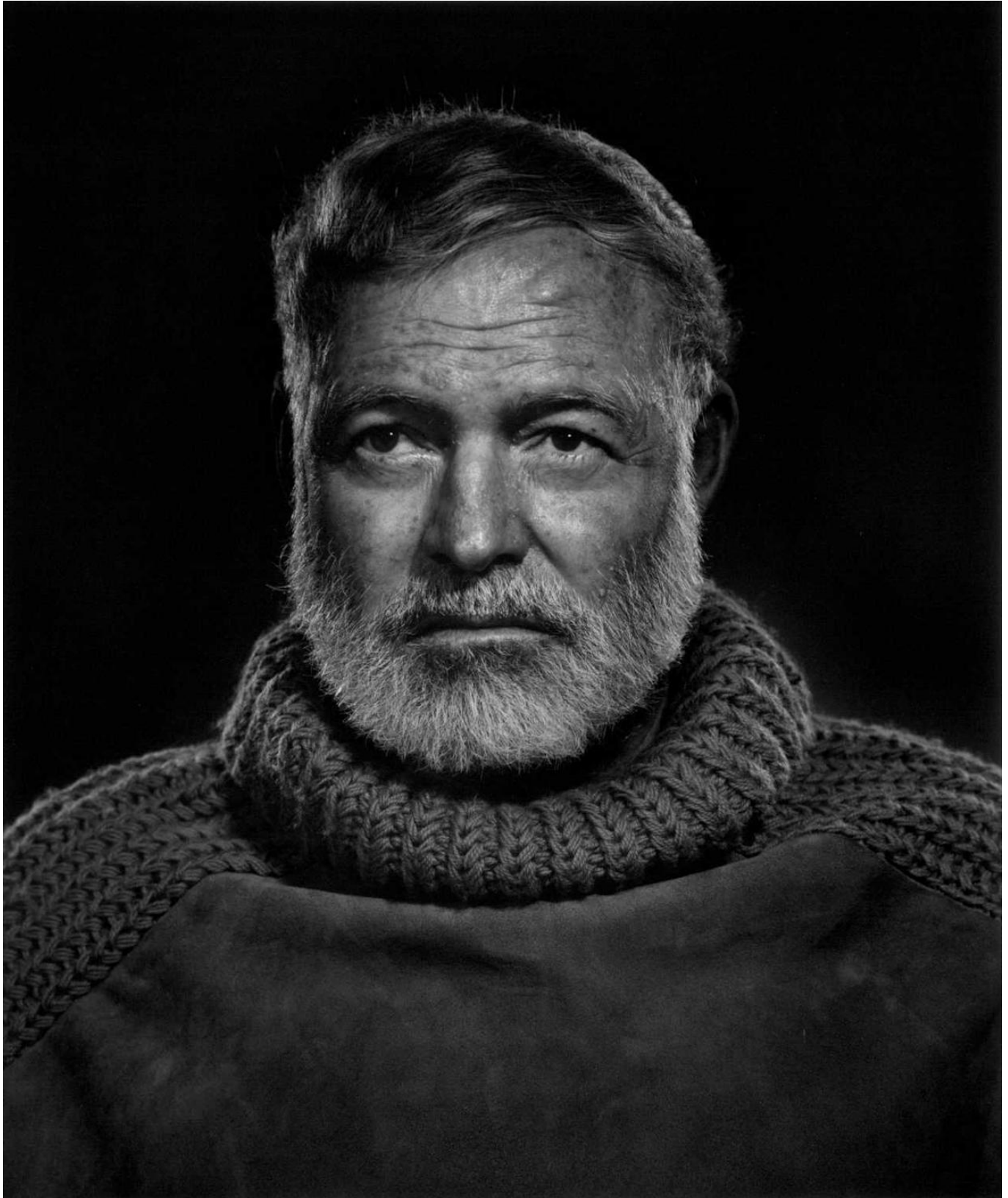

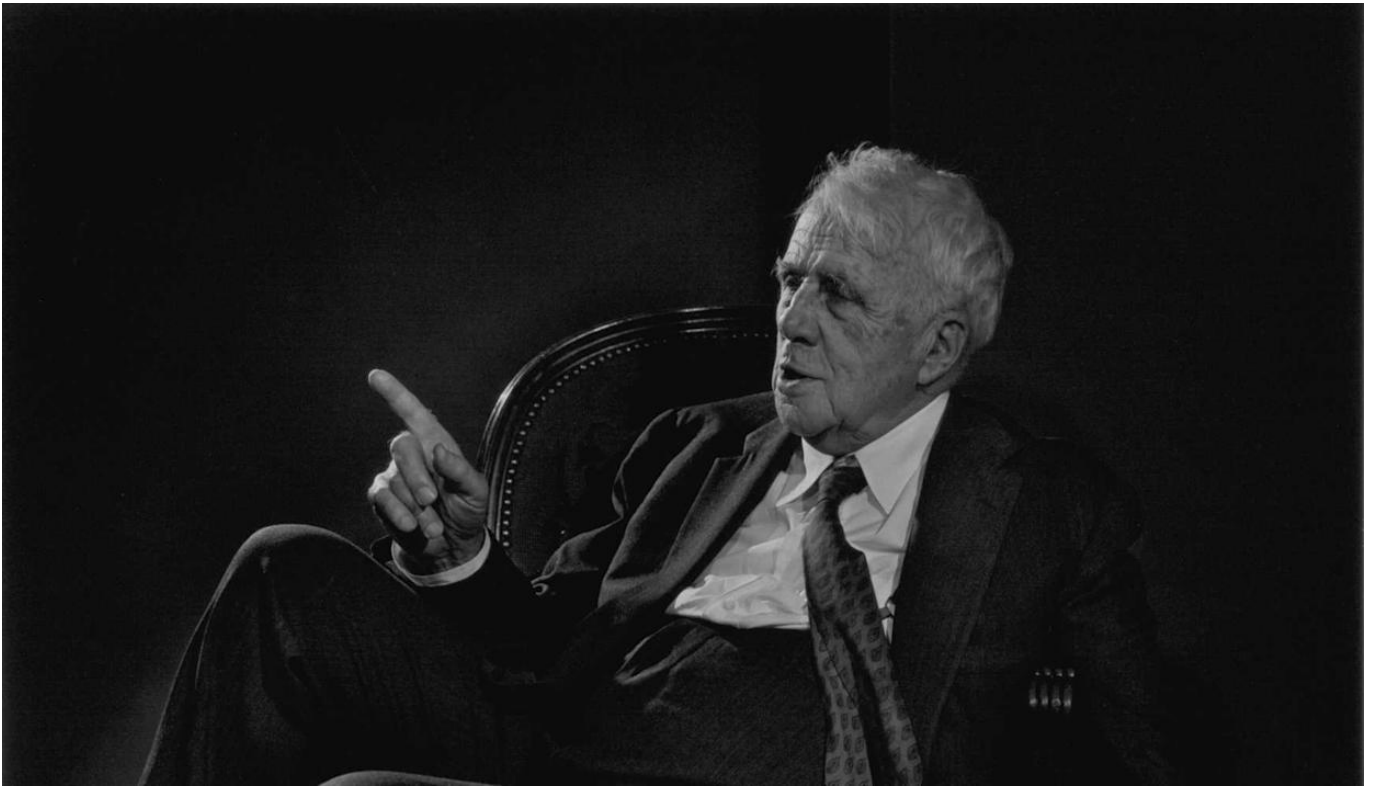

Visitors will find 83 works by 28 portrait photographers, including images by Antony Armstrong-Jones (Lord Snowdon), Richard Avedon, Yousuf Karsh, Gisèle Freund, Berenice Abbott, Imogen Cunningham, and Garry Winogrand, among others. The exhibition also traces how portrait photography expanded from earlier reproducible formats like the carte de visite to iconic images that helped build, challenge, or recast public reputations.

NCMA is located at One Museum Drive, off Northern Boulevard in Roslyn Harbor. Hours are Tuesday through Sunday, 11 a.m. to 4:45 p.m. Admission is \$15 for adults, \$10 for seniors (65+), and \$5 for students and children ages 4 to 12. Docents lead gallery tours daily at 2 p.m., and the mansion tour is set for 1 p.m. Saturdays; both are free with museum admission. Admission to the property is free of charge.
